

A sound mind comes from a sound body which is possible through the intake of healthy food, exercise, and personal hygienic practices. For children, they follow their own behaviour and standard from what they have been taught or what they have learnt from others.

For many at Tereo School, personal hygiene is not taught

at home. In addition, learners do not always have access to flushing toilets or running water.

Practicing personal hygiene helps a child to feel good about themselves, which is important for mental health. Poor health among school children is often the result of inadequate sanitary knowledge and the health benefits of personal hygiene. (WHO 2017)



As part of our drive to make a difference to our learners, the teachers and support staff at Tereo are often the people who teach learners personal hygiene habits including how to use a flushing toilet, wipe their bum, brush teeth, cut nails, use a dust bin, wash hands effectively, etc.

We even go so far as to cut hair for those learners who cannot afford to do so.

Ensuring personal dignity - As part of our programme to ensure dignity we try to provide each learner with a set of panties or underpants. We also try to provide our young girls going through puberty, with a set of bras (see example) and sanitary pads, which is often beyond the financial means of their families.
